- Applicants must be primary members of OTIS Federal Credit Union*

- Applicants must begin their higher education within one year of completing high school.

Application Requirements

- Complete the scholarship application.
- Tell us in 300-400 words why you should be considered for this scholarship.
- Copy of letter of acceptance from college, university, or technical school of choice.
- Letter of recommendation from teacher or guidance counselor with application.
- Senior photo to share if selected as recipient.

Selection

Applications must be received no later than April 25, 2026. The applications will be reviewed by the scholarship committee and finalists chosen from the submitted entries. Scholarship recipients will be notified by their school or presented during their school awards ceremony. Funds will be disbursed to the students after completion of their first semester.

OTIS Federal Credit Union reserves the right to discontinue the scholarship program at any time without notice. OTIS FCU reserves the right not to award any scholarships should there be no qualified applicants.

Awarding of Scholarship
